**Harcourt Hill, Oxford
Carriageway Maintenance Works**

I am writing to inform you that Oxfordshire County Council will be undertaking carriageway maintenance work on Harcourt Hill, between Westminster Way and Vernon Avenue.

The works are programmed to start on **Tuesday 15 August 2017** and are expected to last for 10 days, subject to any bad weather conditions or unforeseen circumstances during construction.

The works will include replacing existing kerbs and ironwork, resurfacing of the existing carriageway, drainage improvements and the replacement of road markings.

Traffic Management

To enable these activities to be carried out safely, the work will be carried out under a road closure. However, in order to keep traffic disruption to a minimum, the work will be done in the following phases:

- Phase 1: Tuesday 15 August to Saturday 19 August, 09:00 to 18:00hrs – full road closure to enable preparation to be carried out, including kerb and ironwork replacement and drainage improvements.
- Phase 2: Monday 21 August to Friday 25 August, 09:00 to 18:00hrs – full road closure to enable the resurfacing work to be carried out and replacement of road markings.

Harcourt Hill will be fully reopened to traffic outside of these periods.

Staff will be positioned at either end of the closure to direct traffic and pedestrians to ensure the safety of the public and workforce. We ask that you give them your full support whether you are a pedestrian, cyclist or motorist.

Every effort will be made to accommodate vehicular access to properties and businesses within and adjacent to the works but this may be subject to some delay depending on the activities being carried out on site. Again, I ask for your support during these periods.

Public Transport

The work will impact the Oxford Bus Company U1 service in the following way:

- Phase 1: Normal U1 service.
- Phase 2: The U1 service will not be able to access Harcourt Hill during phase 2 of the roadworks. The final stop will be at Raleigh Park Road where it will then divert onto the A34 back to the Botley Road via Botley Interchange. The Oxford bound stops on Westminster Way will be temporarily suspended during this period and a temporary stop will be installed opposite house No. 156, passengers wishing to travel to Oxford should use this temporary stop or the stop at Raleigh Park Road, see attached plan.

The bus service will operate as normal outside of our working hours.
